

**Who will explain the provision which is available to my child?**

Information about the provision in individual subjects can be discussed with class teachers. There are two formal parents' evenings during the academic year, but teachers can meet with parents/carers at any point to discuss a child's progress. If a child is given a Pupil Profile or a SEND support plan, teachers will arrange to meet with parents and carers more regularly depending on the nature of reviewing requirements.

In the case of individual or small group interventions, the SENCO will write to parents/carers explaining the aims of the intervention. Letters, phone calls or emails will be used to keep parents/carers updated on their child's progress and to discuss in more detail if required.
