- <u>Work:</u> All children will receive an invite to join **Google Classroom** tomorrow (Tuesday). Work will start to be loaded onto the classroom this Wednesday. You can email, chat, upload your work with your class teacher using this platform. Please look out for the invitation and guide tomorrow!
- Books: Each week we will organise a slot for you to come to the playground and change your child's reading book. If you have children in different year groups, you are welcome to exchange both sets of books at this time. You must return the books you have already read otherwise we will run out of books to share! We ask you to operate strict social distancing at this time for the safety of yourself and others and use the hand gel provided. In order to make this manageable, we are asking that you select books that you feel are appropriate.
