Dear Parents and Carers

We are extremely sorry about the system error which left so many of you confused this morning and without the vital information you needed for the first day back. We have looked into the fault and believe it to have been a one-off error and are putting in other measures to help avoid it happening again.

Just a few reminders about day-to-day things.

- **Dogs on site :** As many of you are aware, dogs are not allowed on the school grounds and the incident this morning has been resolved. Thank you for your calmness and understanding. Dogs can be tied at the railings, providing the dog is not distressed by being left and will not attack other dogs. A distressed animal can be very frightening to children and we want everyone to feel safe and happy when coming to school.
- <u>Uniform, hair and hair bands:</u> We are very proud of our school uniform and seeing how smart the children look when they come in each morning. Long hair, including fringes which fall over the eyes, should be tied back with scrunchie or plain band, or can be held with a plain hairband (black or green).
- **Book bags:** These should be bottle-green.
- **Parking:** Please do not park at the top of the school gates opposite the wavy yellow lines. We know that parking is very tight around the street, however cars turning in the circle present an additional hazard for children.

PE days and kit

Children should come to school in their PE kit on designated PE days. We have had to change the days for some classes because we now have individual class groups and can no longer fit everyone into one day. These days are:

Reception = Tuesday only (amended) Years 1-3 = Tues and Thursday Year 4 = Monday and Thursday
