School places information

Children born between 1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019 are due to start school in September 2023. You need to apply **before 15th January 2023** - even if your child already attends our preschool. To apply online - click here.

For children currently in Year 4, you will need to apply for a place at middle school **before 15th January 2023**. <u>To apply online - click here</u>.

Early and late collection of children

Please be reminded that the school day ends <u>at 3.20pm</u>. This means that children cannot be collected before this time <u>unless it is for exceptional circumstances only</u>. Please note, we <u>cannot</u> release children early for reasons such as children have a swimming lesson or that a parent/carer has a personal errand.

Further to this we have had a few cases of children being collected late after school. If you know you are running late, then please contact the school to let us know of your whereabouts and expected arrival time.

When children are collected late without any notification and/or in <u>unexceptional circumstances</u>, it does become a safeguarding matter. Thank you for your support on this matter.

Car parking

Please be reminded that you must not park your car in the school's entrance way. This is to ensure that there is good visibility for all pedestrians - and in the event of needing emergency services on site that they can safely and swiftly gain access to the grounds.
